POSITION SUMMARY

CRC is seeking a full-time, *fellowship-trained interventional radiologist* to support our growing practice in Cincinnati. This position will spend a majority of the time in IR, balanced with non-subspecialty diagnostic imaging. Candidates must bring a desire to work in a collaborative environment with local referring physicians.
